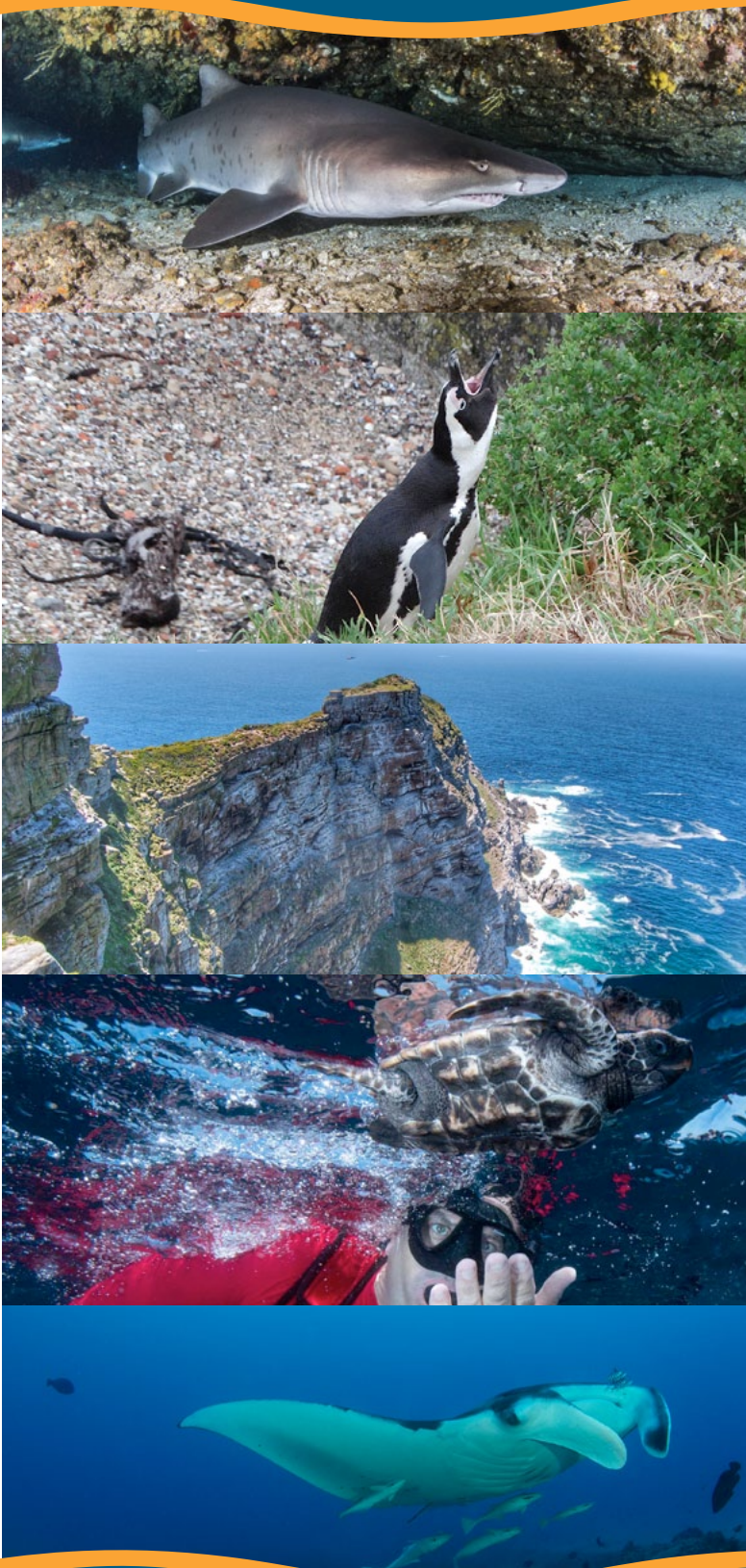

OUR VIRTUAL TOUR WILL INCLUDE:

ALIWAL SHOAL MPA

Aliwal Shoal is a popular dive site where ragged-tooth sharks are in abundance for five months of the year.

BETTY'S BAY MPA

Featuring the Stony Point African Penguin colony.

TABLE MOUNTAIN MPA

Located in a transition zone between the south Western Cape bioregion and the Agulhas bioregion.

TURTLE REHABILITATION AT TWO OCEANS AQUARIUM

Working tirelessly to contribute to the recovery of sea turtle numbers worldwide. MPAs are important nesting and feeding sites for turtles.

DE HOOP MPA

This MPA forms part of the very important migratory route and calving area for southern right whales.

uTHUKELA MPA

A key area for linefish recovery, and a nursery area for hammerhead sharks.

iSIMANGALISO MPA

Protecting nesting areas for sea turtles and offshore threatened species such as the coelacanth.
